- 1. The ASEAN Development Education Project, in cooperation with NADEC-Philippines, College of Education, University of the Philippines, and the Ministry of Education and Culture will conduct a National Live-In Seminar-Workshop on Special Education at the Benitez Memorial Center, September 29-October 3, 1981.
- 2. The Sub-Project on Special Education, also being conducted in the other ASEAN member-countries, will help ASEAN nations develop their own capabilities in providing more effective Special Education services to children with special needs.

- 6. In view of the importance of the project and the need to pursue its objectives, the participants, led by the Regional Supervisor In-Charge of Special Education, are hereby requested to submit a status report on Special Education in the Region, using the inclosed form.
- 7. The status report should be submitted to NADEC-Philippines, College of Education, University of the Philippines, Diliman, Quezon City, on or before <u>September 15, 1981</u>.
- 8. Travelling expenses from the region and back will be charged against the funds of the ASEAN Development Education Project. In case of official delegates from Regions IX, X, XI, and XII air tickets will be issued upon receipt and confirmation of officially designated participants by NADEC-Philippines. However, in the case of the delegates from the other regions travel expenses will be reimbursed in Quezon City upon submission of tickets and/or receipts. In all cases these transactions will be subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures. Board and lodging will be provided to all participants for the duration of the Workshop.
- 9. It is understood that participants will check in at the Benitez Memorial Center on Monday, September 28, 1981.
