LIVE-IN SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON EVALUATION RESEARCH

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Chiefs of Services and Head of Units
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The Technological University of the Philippines (TUP), in cooperation with the Ministry of Education and Culture and the Carl Duisberg-Gesellschaft (Phil.) Inc., will sponsor a six-day live-in seminar-workshop on evaluation research on November 16-21, 1981, at the National Manpower and Youth Council (NMYC) complex, Bicutan, Taguig Metro Manila.
2. The theme of the seminar-workshop is "Research for National Development."
3. The workshop is aimed at strengthening evaluation research by developing further the participants' capabilities in: a) identifying and prioritizing research needs in technology development; b) conducting scientific research in education and industry; and c) advising with confidence dissertation/thesis writers and special project proponents. The workshop will likewise aim at further developing awareness of and appreciation for the value of the findings from evaluation research in decision making.
4. Participants in the seminar-workshop shall be limited only to those involved in advising thesis/dissertation writers and/or planning research and evaluation.
5. Inclosed is a bio-data form which should be filled out by the nominees and sent to: The Graduate School, Technological University of the Philippines, Ayala Boulevard, Ermita, Manila on or before October 30, 1981. Applicants chosen to participate in the seminar-workshop will be notified by the TUP. Those who may wish to register earlier may come to the abovementioned office.

6. A registration fee of ₱400 shall be charged each participant to defray expenses for board and lodging and handouts. Expenses incurred in connection with this seminar-workshop shall be charged against local fund, subject to availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules.

7. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is requested.
