1981 HEALTH EDUCATION WEEK

- 1. Conformably to Presidential Proclamation No. 255, dated August 29, 1967 Health Education Week will be observed from October 11 to 17, 1981. The theme of the celebration is "Health Education and Development in the 80s".
- 2. In view of the importance of health education, all schools are enjoined to observe the Week with appropriate activities. A suggested list of activities is inclosed for reference.
- 3. A work-conference will be held at the Philippine Normal College Community-School Health Education Center Auditorium, Ayala Boulevard, Manila from October 12 to 14, 1981. The general objective is to review the current status of school health education, identifying its strengths, weaknesses/gaps with the end in view of formulating guidelines, plans and strategies for strengthening the program. The following are the specific objectives:
 - a. Device plans and framework for defining further the curriculum in school health education in the primary and secondary schools.
 - b. Device plans for strengthening teacher preparation in school health education pre-service and inservice.
 - c. Device models and procedures for creating support mechanisms to further the development of health education program.
 - 4. The traveling expenses of participants may be charged against local funds, subject to availability of funds and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Expenses of participants from private agencies may be charged from their respective offices.

- 5. The officers and members of the Health Education Association of the Philippines, Inc. (HEAP), health education supervisors, teacher educators, school physicians, dentists, nurses, principals/administrators, coordinators, YDT-CAT department neads, and other school personnel involved in health education in both public and private schools are enjoined to attend the celebration.
- 6. It is desired that this Memorandum be disseminated to all concerned.
