FIRST ANNUAL WORK-CONFERENCE OF THE VOCATIONAL
COLLEGES ASSOCIATION OF THE PHILIPPINES

To: Bureau Directors

Vocational Schools Superintendents/Administrators

1. The Vocational Colleges Association of the Philippines (VCAP) in coordination with the Ministry of Education and Culture will hold its first annual work-conference at the Marikina Institute of Science and Technology, Marikina, Metro Manila on December 9-11, 1981 with the theme, "The Role of the VCAP in the Kilusang Kabuhayan at Kaunlaran (KKK)."

2. The main objective of the work-conference is to help sustain economic growth and assist in the equitable distribution of benefits and in the total human development of the Philippines. Specifically, the work-conference seeks to come up with:

- a. Clear manifestation of the role of VCAP in achieving the goals of the movement;
- b. Prepare work programs in support of the movement; and
- c. Organize the regional and local VCAP member institutions as conduit with other organizations in carrying out projects and activities.

3. The work-conference of the Vocational Colleges Association of the Philippines has for its major area of discussion the implication of the KKK as it relates to the a) curriculum in agriculture, arts/trades and fishery education; b) solving projects management; and c) manpower skills training.

4. In view of the need to accelerate the capability of each member-institution in its commitment to the KKK the superintendent/administrator together with the dean/head of the college department are enjoined to attend.
5. A conference fee of ₱250 per delegate to cover cost of conference materials and handouts will be charged.
6. Inclosed is the program of activities and a list of the participating institutions.
