ANNUAL CONVENTION-WORKSHOP OF THE COUNCIL OF DEANS AND HEADS OF HOME ECONOMICS IN THE PHILIPPINES

- 1. The Council of Deans and Heads of Home Economics in the Philippines (CODHHEP) in cooperation with the Ministry of Education and Culture will hold its 2-day annual convention-workshop on December 4-5, 1981 at the Multi-Purpose Center of the College of Home Economics, University of the Philippines, Diliman, Quezon City.
- 2. The theme of the convention-workshop is "Respect for Life", focusing on the Kilusang Kabuhayan sa Kaunlaran (KKK) program and aiming at the preparation of an outreach program for home economics departments all over the country.
- 3. In view of the educational benefits that may be derived from attending the convention-workshop, this Office enjoins deans and heads of home economics of both the public and private schools, as well as division and regional supervisors in charge of the home economics program to attend this workshop.
- 4. Each participant will pay a registration fee of thirty pesos (\$\participant\$) to cover expenses for snacks, handouts and documentation. Expenses incurred by the participants from the government sector in connection with this convention may be charged against local funds, subject to availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules. The private schools may have their own arrangements regarding the expenses of their participants.
