NATIONAL WORKSHOP ON IN-SERVICE EDUCATION
FOR ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TEACHERS

To: Bureau Directors
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities

1. In connection with projects of the National Development Group for Educational Innovation (NDGEI) which relate to in-service education, a national workshop will be held on November 20 to 21, 1981 at the Language Center, Philippine Normal College, Manila.
2. The workshop will provide a forum for discussion on the state of the art in in-service teacher education at the elementary level in terms of (a) research and (b) training.
3. Two studies: (a) "In-service Education for Primary Teachers: Design Formulation" and (b) "Researches on In-service Education for Primary Teachers in the Philippines: A Review" will be the focus of discussion. The term "primary teachers" in the two titles refers to elementary grades teachers.
4. At the end of the workshop the participants should be able to present:
 - a. reactions, comments on and recommendations for the improvement of the aforementioned research reports; and
 - b. revisions on research reports on the bases of reactions, comments and suggestions.
