JOINT NATIONAL WORK-CONFERENCE OF THE FFP, FAHP
AND FFPCC ORGANIZATIONS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

1. The Joint National Work-Conference of the Future Farmers of the Philippines (FFP) Inc., Future Agricultural Homemakers of the Philippines (FAHP) Inc., and the Future Farmers of the Philippines Collegiate Chapter (FFPCC) will be held on January 26-28, 1982 at the Sudlon Agricultural School, Lahug, Cebu City. The theme of the joint conference is "Gearing the FFP and FAHP Activities Toward the Objectives and Thrust of the Kilusang Kabuhayan sa Kaunlaran." The objectives of the conference are found in Inclosure No. 1. Also inclosed is a list of officials of the conference.
2. The participants authorized to attend this work-conference are the following:
 - a. One student delegate from each school chapter of the FFP, FAHP and FFPCC duly registered in the regional and national organizations;
 - b. Students and adults who are national officers of the FFP, FAHP and FFPCC;
 - c. Members of the national board;
 - d. Local chapter adviser of the FFP, FAHP and FFPCC;
 - e. Chairman and members of the advisory council - FFP-FAHP school chapter;
 - f. Regional directors or chiefs of the Secondary Education Division;
 - g. Regional chairmen;
 - h. Regional executive secretary-treasurers;
 - i. Regional FFP and FAHP advisers; and
 - j. Regional coordinators.
3. A registration fee of ₱250 for each adult and FFPCC delegate will be charged to cover expenses for leadership training, handouts, etc. An institutional fee of ₱700 will be charged each school chapter to cover

cost of conference supplies and materials, printing of convention proceedings, souvenir program and other necessary expenses for the work-conference.

4. Expenses in connection with the attendance of the participants will be charged against the following sources of funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations:

- a. student delegates - local FFP-FAHP-FFPCC chapter funds;
- b. National student officers - national FFP-FAHP funds;
- c. Adult officials - local school funds;
- d. Regional adult officers - MEC regional funds; and
- e. MEC-BSE officials and staff - BSE funds.

5. Each student participant is requested to bring souvenir items for exchange gift during the closing rites of the convention.

6. All delegates to the convention shall be at the convention site on January 25. Expected departure date is January 29.

7. A program to improve the leadership competencies in conducting the FFP and FAHP activities for adult participants and the FFPCC delegates will be conducted hand in hand with the joint work-conference of the students.

8. The program of activities for the work-conference, participants by school chapters, advisers, school and other officials with assignments in the work-conference, members of the different working committees and other instructions relevant to the work-conference will be issued in a separate memorandum by the FFP-FAHP national adviser.

9. It is desired that this Memorandum be given the widest publicity for the information and guidance of all concerned.
