NATIONAL WORKSHOP FOR TRAINERS OF TEACHERS  
IN SPECIAL EDUCATION

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents

1. The Bureau of Elementary Education, Ministry of Education and Culture and the UNESCO Regional Office for Education in Asia and the Pacific (ROEAP), Bangkok, Thailand, will conduct a National Workshop for Trainers of Teachers in Special Education at Merikina Institute of Science and Technology, Metro Manila, on November 2-13, 1981.

2. The objective of this workshop is to develop trainers for the mobile training program for teachers. Specifically, the workshop aims to:

- a. prepare a "Handbook on Special Education" for the mobile training program for teachers in Special Education;
- b. evolve a model training design for trainers in Special Education; and
- c. equip trainers with skills and knowledge essential in training teachers of exceptional children.

3. The participants in this seminar-workshop shall be composed of twenty-six selected teachers, preferably with previous training in Special Education from all MEC regions. Inclosed is a list of participants. Board and lodging will be provided to all participants for the duration of the workshop.

4. Travelling expenses from the region and back will be charged against UNESCO funds for the project. In the case of official delegates from Regions VI, VII, VIII, IX,

X, XI, and XII, air tickets will be issued upon confirmation of availability of the officially designated participants by the Regional Office concerned. Such information should be relayed to the Special Education Division, B.E.E. on or before October 23. In the case of the delegates from the other regions, travel expenses will be reimbursed at Marikina, Metro Manila upon submission of tickets and/or receipts. In all cases these transactions will be subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures.

5. Participants and staff shall assemble at the MEC compound, Arroceros, Manila at 8:00 A.M. on Monday, November 2. Transportation from the assembly point to Marikina will be provided.

6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is desired.
