7TH NATIONAL CONFERENCE-WORKSHOP ON MARITIME EDUCATION

1. The Philippine Association of Maritime Institutions (PAMI) will sponsor the 7th Annual Conference-Workshop on Maritime Education at the Manila Royal Hotel, Sta. Cruz, Manila on November 8-9, 1981 with the theme: "The Role of PAMI in Maritime Education Towards National Progress."
2. This conference-workshop will serve as a forum for member schools to:
 - a. review and finalize programs and projects;
 - b. revise/upgrade curricular programs in Maritime Education;
 - c. set up programs for faculty development; and
 - d. firm up linkages with maritime industry.
3. Maritime schools may send as participants the head of school, registrar, chairman of the Department of Marine Engineering, superintendent of nautical schools and two Maritime members of the faculty.
4. Registration fee of one hundred pesos (P100) will be collected from each participant to defray conference expenses, chargeable against local/school funds of each participating school.
5. The program of activities for the two-day conference-workshop is inclosed.

1. Curriculum Development - Look into the curriculum of BSMT, Naval Architecture, Marine Engineering, Electronics AME which are included in the kit. Revise/upgrade said curricula.
