TRAINING FOR OFFICIATING SEPAK TAKRAW

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

1. The Asian Sepak Takraw Federation and the Sepak Takraw Association of the Philippines will jointly sponsor a training program in officiating Sepak Takraw to be held in the Sepak Takraw Gymnasium at the Rizal Memorial Sports Complex, Dakota St., Ermita, Manila, on November 23-27, 1981.
2. The abovementioned training is intended for those who were selected to officiate during the 1981 SEA Games in December 1981. However, for the purpose of having accredited Sepak Takraw officials from all the regions, participants to the Sepak Takraw national clinic held on Sept. 15-Oct. 9, 1981 in Legazpi City, Tacloban City, Zamboanga City and Vigan, Ilocos Sur whose names appear in the inclosed list are recommended to attend.
3. Further, this Office wishes to announce that all the participants who attended the said Sepak Takraw National Clinic passed the written and practical examinations conducted by the MEC consultants and they can now teach and coach students and athletes. They can also help plan, manage and conduct Sepak Takraw tournaments in their divisions.
4. Transportation, board and lodging expenses relative to this training shall be charged against local/school board funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures.
5. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
