FATHER'S DAY AND MOTHER'S DAY CELEBRATIONS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Chiefs of Services and Heads of Units
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

1. The National Federation of Women's Clubs, in cooperation with the Ministry of Education and Culture, is spearheading this year's celebration of Father's Day and Mother's Day. Pursuant to Proclamation No. 2037 dated November 27, 1980, Father's Day and Mother's Day will be celebrated every year on the first Sunday and first Monday, respectively, of December.
2. The theme for this year's celebrations are "Father's Role in Family Solidarity" and "Mother's Role in Family Solidarity."
3. To inculcate in our children and youth and thereby preserve the Filipino virtue and tradition of deep respect for parents, it is desired that all schools celebrate these significant days and lead the community in the observance of the celebrations.
4. Some suggested activities for the celebrations, in addition to discussion of the themes in subjects like Filipino, English and Social Studies are the following:
 - a. Hold Flag ceremony in every school followed by a literary-musical program featuring families that have promoted solidarity by engaging in activities that enhance the artistic talents common among the members.
 - b. Invite speakers to speak on the theme of the celebrations.
 - c. Conduct an essay writing contest on the themes of Father's Day and Mother's Day.

- d. Encourage the Kabataang Barangay to undertake community projects paying tribute to parents.
5. To highlight the observance of Father's Day and Mother's Day, schools may revive the tradition of school children wearing flowers of appropriate color, i.e., pink or red for non-orphans, white for total orphans and partial orphans.
6. The cooperation of all school officials and teachers in public and private schools is hereby enjoined to insure the success of the celebrations.
7. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
