COMPETITIVE FYAMINATION FOR THE PRESIDENT FERBINAND F. MARCOS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM FOR FISHEFIES

1. An open and competitive examination for the purpose of selecting scholars for the President Perdinand F. Marcos Scholarship Program for Fisheries will be conducted on February 20, 1982 for 2-1/2 hours. The examination will include test items in the Sciences (Biology, Chemistry and Physics), Mathematics (Applied Arithmetic, Algebra and Geometry), and English (Grammar and Reading Comprehension, and Basic Fisheries). It will be administered by the FFM Scholarship Program Secretariat assisted by a maximum of five (5) proctors designated by the MEC regional director in the following testing centers:

- 2. The results of this examination and the list of fishery schools and colleges were the successful examinees may erroll as FFM scholars will be announced in March 1982, copy furnished the office of the provincial/city school superintendents through the MFC regional director.
- 3. The FYM Scholarship Program for Fisheries provides for school year 1982-1983 a maximum of five (5) scholars per region for college studies leading to the degree of Pachelor of Science in Fisheries.
- 4. A scholar under this program will be entitled to: a) free matriculation and other school fees; b) book allowance per semester; c) monthly stipend of \$700; and d) thesis support and graduation expenses.
- 5. Pigh school graduates/graduating students who are certified to by their respective school heads as among the top ten in the graduating class to which they belong, based on their final grades in all required third and fourth year subjects, in the case of high school graduates or on their third final grades in all required third year subjects and ratings during the first and second grading periods in all required fourth year subjects, in the case of those graduating from high school during the school year 1981-1982, are eligible to take the competitive examination for this scholarship program. It is understood that the applicants are Filipino citizens, of good moral standing, physically fit, free from any criminal, civil or administrative liability, and genuinely interested to pursue college studies in fisheries.
- 6. Applicants for scholarship under this program should file their application on or before January 9, 1982 using the inclosed application form, through the Provincial/City/Division FFM Scholarship Screening Committee. The Committee shall be composed of the provincial/city school superintendent as Chairman, the Provincial Governor/City Mayor as Co-Chairman, and Assemblyman representing the province, the President of the Local Mayor's League and the PFAR Provincial Program Officer, as members. Application forms may be obtained from the office of the provincial/city schools superintendent.
- 7. The provincial/city schools superintendent shall forward the applications of qualified applicants, through the FEC Regional Director, to the FEM Scholarship Program Secretariat, Arcadia Bldg., 860 Ouezon Avenue, Ouezon City, Metro Manila to reach the said Office on or Defore January 26, 1982.

8. It is desired that the contents of this Memorandum be immediately disseminated and given the widest publicity possible for the information and guidance of all concerned.
