FLOATING SEMINAR AND EDUCATIONAL TOUR

1. The Polytechnic University of the Philippines (PUP)-Sister Universities Association of Asia and the Pacific organized by the PUP Faculty, Club, Inc., will sponsor a Floating Seminar and Educational Tour aboard M.V. Philippine Princess on April 6-8, 1982, in cooperation with the Ministry of Education and Culture. The theme of the seminar is "Education and Change."

2. The objectives of the seminar are as follows:

- a. To contribute to the improvement of education in the country;
- b. To provide a forum for the exchange of experience among educators and researchers involved in various aspects of education and change;
- c. To identify immediate and future education research needs that are common to SUAAP member universities as well as those that are unique to each university;
- d. To share experiences and viewpoints which could be relevant in other schools in Asia and the Pacific; and
- e. To encourage the utilization of new technology particularly in multiplying the resources of the present formal and non-formal educational systems.

3. The seminar and tour is open to teachers in all levels, both public and private. A fee of ₱400 to cover the registration fee, round trip cruise fare, meals and materials, will be charged each participant. A ₱50 deposit should be paid together with the application on or before February 8, 1982. It is understood that no government funds shall be spent by the teacher-participant in connection with his attendance in this seminar.
