REORIENTATION SEMINAR ON THE REVISED  
IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS  
OF THE STUDY NOW PAY LATER PLAN

To: Bureau Directors

1. The National Educational Loan Assistance Center, Ministry of Education and Culture will hold a reorientation seminar for all Study Now Pay Later Plan regional coordinators, on February 24-26, 1982 at Marikina Institute of Science and Technology, Marikina, Metro Manila. Inclosed is the program of activities.

2. The objectives of the seminar are the following:

- a) To re-orient the SNPLP coordinators on the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of the Educational Assistance Act of 1976, P.D. No. 932.
- b) To strengthen the coordinating and monitoring activities of the SNPLP Regional Coordinators in order to enhance the effective implementation of the program in all the regions.
- c) To thresh out and adopt remedial measures and/or solutions to problems encountered in the implementation of the Study Now Pay Later Plan.
- d) To re-vitalize the coordinating activities of the SNPLP coordinators with the officials of the Ministry of Labor and Employment (MOLE), the Personnel

Management Association of the Philippines (PMAP), and other employing agencies for the job placement of graduated grantees.

- e) To acquire feedbacks on SNPLP matters which may be useful for policy formulation and system renewal.
- f) To develop regional plan of action for specific areas of concern.
- g) To assess/evaluate annually the SNPLP program in the regions.

3. Slots for each region for the school year 1982-83 will likewise be distributed during the seminar.
