1982 INTENSIFIED SCHOOL-BASED COMMUNITY-ORIENTED  
DRUG ABUSE PREVENTION AND CONTROL PROGRAM

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
School Superintendents  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Founders of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities  
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

1. The MEC-DDB-UNESCO Special Project on Drug Abuse Prevention Education has started the implementation of the Intensified School-Based Community-Oriented Drug Abuse Prevention and Control Program in answer to the rising incidence of the problem of drug abuse among children and youth in the schools and communities.

2. The objective is to prevent and control drug abuse among children and youth by strengthening national consciousness and developing desirable cultural and moral values through different modalities.

3. Areas with high incidence of drug abuse have been identified and the implementation of the program has started in some of these areas. Regions I, IV and VII are the target areas for the year 1982.

4. To prepare the program personnel from these regions for the implementation of the project, a national seminar-workshop will be conducted in Banot Lake Resort, San Pablo City from January 31 to February 7, 1982. The regions concerned are requested to send two (2) regional supervisors and two (2) division supervisors from each school division to attend the seminar-workshop.

5. Inasmuch as these officials will serve as the program coordinator-trainers in their respective areas, it is suggested that the following criteria be considered in selecting the delegates to the seminar-workshop:

- A -

- a. They should not be more than 55 years old.
- b. They should have good public relations with school administrators, municipal government officials and community leaders.
- c. They should have good communication skills.
- d. They should preferably be in charge of Health Education or Guidance (Enclosed is Project Form 1)
- e. It is requested that they bring with them the following:
  - a. action programme on drug abuse prevention education of different government agencies, civic and religious organizations in their respective communities.
  - b. Analysis of the drug situation in their respective communities. Enclosed is a Survey Instrument (Form 2) to help them conduct the survey.
- f. Expenses incident to the attendance at the seminar-workshop will be charged against the MEC-DDR-UNESCO Special Project funds.
- g. It is desired that this Memorandum be given preferential attention and action.
