1982 SUMMER CLASSES IN PHYSICAL EDUCATION AT PUP

1. The Institute of Physical Education and Sports of the Polytechnic University of the Philippines will offer a program leading to a Certificate in Physical Education during the Summer Term of 1982 for teachers of both public and private schools and colleges, and for college students majoring in Physical Education. Inclosed is the list of courses leading to a Certificate in Physical Education.

2. The program which starts on April 12 and ends on May 29, is aimed at improving the competence of physical education teachers and providing them with knowledge and skills to become sports coaches, athletic managers and referees.

3. The maximum load for summer enrolees in this course will be ten (10) units (six theoretical and four practical). Successful completion of the summer course will be credited toward a Certificate in Physical Education which requires forty (40) units.

4. Application for enrolment may be sent to the Director, Institute of Physical Education and Sports, or to the Registrar, Polytechnic University of the Philippines, Sta. Mesa, Manila. Registration period will be on April 1-6, from 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.
