MEC-SSWAP-MSSD NATIONAL WORKSHOP  
ON SOCIAL WORK EDUCATION

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The Schools of Social Work Association of the Philippines (SSWAP), in coordination with the Ministry of Education and Culture and the Ministry of Social Services and Development, will hold its 7th National Workshop on Social Work Education at the Teachers' Camp, Baguio City, on February 24-27, 1982.

2. Pursuant to national goals, the theme of the national workshop is "Social Work Education: A Vision for the 80s". The objectives are:

- a. to describe the state of social work education and practice in the context of contemporary Philippine society.
- b. to identify the conditions of the different schools of social work from which commonalities and differences of perspectives may stem.
- c. to identify contributions of the individual schools of social work in the Philippines to the over-all social development of their local situation/environment.
- d. to evolve a common perspective of contemporary Philippine society as basis for drawing out projections in social work education for the 80s.

3. On account of the timeliness and significance of the theme and objectives of the workshop, all heads of schools concerned are enjoined to send delegates to the workshop. The chiefs of higher education divisions and/or supervisors particularly for social work, in the MEC regional offices, are expected to attend.

4. Attendance is on official time. Registration fee is ₱350 which includes transportation for Manila-Baguio and Baguio-Manila, board accommodations and workshop materials. For those not joining the Manila-Baguio and Baguio-Manila trip, the registration fee is ₱300. Expenses incurred by the participants should be charged against local funds in the case of government employees, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules. Expenses of participants from private educational institutions should be borne by their respective schools.

5. Inclosed is the program of activities.

6. Immediate dissemination and implementation of the contents of this Memorandum is desired.
