BVNS 1982 SUMMER CLASSES

Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

- 1. The 1982 summer classes at the Baguio Vacation Normal School (BVNS) will start on April 20 and end on May 29.
- 2. Classroom teachers may take undergraduate/graduate courses or special leadership courses at the Baguio Vacation Normal School. School officials and other school personnel who are on vacation and sick leave basis may enrol also with the approval of their superintendents.
- 3. School officials and teachers from non-government schools are likewise encouraged to enrol in the courses offered at BVNS. The general requirements and other pertinent information about the summer classes are found in Inclosure No. 2.
- 4. BVNS offers the following areas of specialization in the graduate and undergraduate levels:
 - a. Master of Arts in Education major in Educational Management (School Administration and Supervision), Educational Media, Adult and Community Education, Guidance and Counseling, Communication Arts (English and Pilipino), Social Studies Education, Science Education, Mathematics Education, Music Education, Functional Literacy, Special Education, Home Economics and Volunteer Management.
 - b. Master of Arts in Teaching (MAT) with fields of concentration in Fre-elementary Education, School Realth Education, Home Economics and Physical Education.
 - c. Courses on Functional Literacy, a special masteral program for teachers of ethnic minorities, which will entitle the participants to a certificate of attendance (if taken as non-credit) or as academic requirements in specific areas of specialization towards a master's degree.

- d. Special courses (undergraduate) in Music Education, Physical Education or any field of concentration offered at the graduate level.
- 5. The subject offerings listed in Inclosure No. 1 for each of the programs are subject to change depending on the priority needs of graduating students, the availability of qualified instructors, and the number of students who will enrol in a class to warrant its organization.
- 6. In order to facilitate the organization of classes on time, teacher-students and other school officials who plan to enrol at the BVNS this summer are requested to accomplish the attached form (Inclosure No. 3) for advanced registration to be sent not later than March 31, 1982 to the National Research and Development Centre for Teacher Education (NRDCTE), Ministry of Education and Culture, Arroceros Street, Manila.
- 7. For short-term leadership courses conducted by the different bureaus, regional offices, units and centers at EVNS which are supportive to MEC educational thrusts, EVNS will give the equivalent credits towards a master's degree or issue certificates of attendance.
- 8. It is desired that the contents of this Memorandum be given the widest publicity possible.

- 1. Registration for enrolment at the BVNS will be from April 9 to 19, 1982 Advanced registration by mail using the prescribed form (Inclosure NO 3) will be accepted. A fine of not exceeding five pesos (₱5.00) will be imposed on enrollees who enroll after the scheduled enrolment period. No student will be admitted after the first week of classes.
- 2. Teacher-students seeking admission at the BVNS for the first time should submit a duly accomplished application form together with his/her original transcript of records upon registration.

- 4. Classes will be held 6 days a week, Monday through Saturday, one period of 60 minutes daily will be scheduled for each 2-unit course; 90 minutes for each 3-unit course; and 145 minutes for each course requiring laboratory experiments.
- 5. The maximum study load for either the undergraduate or the graduate level is nine (9) units in accordance with BPS Circular No. 7, s. 1973. Graduate students not carrying the full load may enroll for credit in special undergraduate course provided that the total number of units shall not exceed nine (9) units. Those who take the full study load are allowed to enroll in one non-credit course.
- 6. Students enrolled in government schools/teachers/college may erroll at the BVNS for vacation classes. They should present to the registrar of the BVNS their official Transcript of Records or Students' Permanent Records duly accomplished and signed by the Registrar of the school, teachers colleges and universities where they are enrolled during the regular school year.
