4TH KB SCHOOL CHAPTER-SURMER LEADERSHIP TRAINING COUPSE (KBSC-SLTC)

Reads of Private Schools. Colleges and Universities

- 1. The Educational Development Department of the Pambansang Katipunan ng Kabataang Barangay (EDD-PKKI) in close coordination with the Ministry of Education and Culture is holding the 4th KB School Chapter-Summer Leadership Training Course (KESC-SLTC) on April 14-19, 1982 at the KB Training Center, Mt. Makiling, Los Baños, Laguna.
- 2. With the theme, "Towards Greater Heights of Success," this year's SLTC aims to:
 - a. provide the participants with the skills and orientation necessary in the fulfillment of their responsibilities as KB leaders in their respective school chapters;
 - t. imbue the participants with an understanding of the tenets of the KE, its role in society and the nation as a whole, and their responsibilities in realizing the objectives of the same;
 - c. acquaint the participants with realities and challenges of the 80s;
 - d. review the 1981 KBSC Organizational and Operational Guidelines to make it more attuned/responsive to the needs of the people; and
 - e. provide an opportunity for the participants to interact and work together with respective KB regional federation presidents with the end in view of drawing up a uniform program of action from the regional to the provincial and city levels for SY 1982-83.
- 3. This Office enjoins all schools, colleges and universities with KE chapters to send two (2) representatives each. Additional representatives may be arranged with the FE regional Operations Centers (KUPOCs), which shall serve as registration centers and schemes for participants mobilization.

4. Participants shall pay corresponding registration fees to help cover board and lodging, training kits, transport to and from the training site, certificates of participation and other miscellaneous expenses, as follows:

a. Regions I-V, and NCR #200 per delegate

b. Regions VI-VIII 150 "

c. Regions IX-XII 100 "

Registration fee and travelling expenses from the regions to Manila and back shall be chargeable against KBSC funds or school funds available for student development/activities or from other local available sources.

- 5. Deadline for submission of names of participants shall be on or before April 3 at their respective KBFOCs.
- 6. Each participant must meet the following qualifications and requirements:
 - a. Have no failing grades in SY 1981-82;
 - b. Be within 15 to 21-age bracket by SY 1982-83;

c. Be an active KESC officer/member;

- d. Be willing to conduct an echo seminar of the training by August 1982 and serve for the entire SY 1982-83 should he/she get elected in the KBSC;
- e. Be physically fit for a 6-day training,

f. Have parent's consent/permit: and

- g. Have three (3) passport-size photos for corresponding bio-data sheets.
- 7. Participants who are enrolled in Summer shall be excused from classes at least one (1) day before and after, one (1) week after the training, should such fall within the examination period, in nursuance of LOI Nos. 373 and 512.
- 8. Participants shall assemble in front of the NEC Central Office, Arroceros, Manila on April 14, from 7:00 to 9:00 A.M. Delegates from Regions IV and V may proceed directly to the training venue, provided accompanied by concerned KBROC personnel.
- 9. Inclosed are the tentative schedule of activities, participant's information/"things-to-bring" sheet, parental consent form, and directory of KBROCs.
- 10. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is hereby enjoined.
