SIGHT SAVING CLUBS

1. The Foundation for the Rehabilitation and Prevention of Blindness in the Philippines, Inc. is an organization working for the prevention of blindness in children and youth.

In order to effectively carry out its objectives and enable it to consolidate voluntary efforts among the students toward the rehabilitation and prevention of blindness among our people, the Foundation is setting up a program for the organization of Sight Saving Clubs in secondary schools, both public and private, in Metro Manila and in all the other regions of the country.

In view of the laudable objectives of the project, this Office hereby endorses the organization of sight saving clubs in secondary schools without prejudice to the student-members' academic load as well as to the teacher-advisers' work load, and ~~provided~~ that membership in the proposed club will be on a purely voluntary basis.
