COST OF LEVING ALLOWANCES UNDER RA 5447 TERMINATED AS OF DECIMEER 31, 1978

- Inclosed is a copy of a letter of the Acting Minister of the Mudget dated October 5, 1931 to the effect that authorizations granted to government employees to receive cost of living allowance, including allowances granted under RA 5447 were terminated as of December 31, 1978 and only the cost of living allowance provided under LOImp No. 116 as implemented by NBC No. 329 s. 1980 at \$\frac{1}{2}\$100 each per month is allowed, unless expressly provided for under subsequent law.
- This Office will take action, in the meanwhile, to obtain a Cabinet or Executive Committee decision on the matter, in the light of an apparently different position of the Commission on Audit.
- 3. It is desired that this Memorandum be brought to the attention of all officials, teachers and employees for their information and guidance.

This refers to the attached requests of the Schools Division Superintendents of Pasay City and Calcocan City, MEC-NCR: for clarification on the status of living allowance of teachers paid by Local School Boards per RA 5447 in relation to LOImp No. 116 as implemented NBC No. 329 dated May 13, 1980.

It is represented that the School Boards in the aforesaid school divisions have been paying their teachers cost of living allowances ranging from 5 to 50% of their annual salary in accordance with the provisions of Republic Acts Nos 4670 (The Magna Carta for Public School Teachers) and 5447 (Special Education Fund Act), in addition to the Ploo monthly allowance from the National Government under LOImp 116

However, in view of the provision of paragraph 3.7 of NBC No. 329 which states among others that no one shall receive cost of living allowance from more than one source, the Metro Manila Commission issued Executive Order No. 80-03 to the City School Boards stopping payment of tost of living allowance from the Special Education Fund, hence these requests.

In a letter of OCPC dated March 4, 1981, relative to a similar query on the status of cost of living allowance of nationally paid teachers of Paranaque, under the Division of City Schools, Pasay City, it cited Letter of Instructions (LOI) No. 779, s. 1978 particularly Sections 1 and 2 which provide as follows:

"l: No official or employee of the national government, including contractual and casual personnel, may receive additional.

compensation, including commutable or reimbursable allowances, from any province, city, municipality or barangay. Neither may any local government unit authorize the payment of additional compensation and allowances to officials and employees in the Legislative, Executive or Judicial Branches of the Government.

"2. Any existing authorization shall terminate as of December 31, 1978."

On the basis of the above-cited provisions, the stand of OCPC was that the Paranaque teachers are no longer entitled to receive the cost of living allowance from the Local School Board effective January 1, 1979. These teachers are however entitled to the cost of living allowance at PlOO each/mo. granted by the national government under NBC No. 329 s. 1980.

Said previous stand of this Office is similarly reiterated on the herein requests of the Schools Division Superintendents of Pasay City and Caloocan City, MEC-NCR. Moreover, with the enactment of RA No. 5447, the cost of living allowance provided in RA No. 4670 has since then been charged to the Special Education Fund which is temporary in character pending the appropriation by the Legislature of the necessary funds for the purpose. LOImp No. 116 as implemented by NBC No. 329, placed within its coverage all public school teachers with respect to the grant and entitlement of cost of living allowance. Furthermore, paragraph 3.7 of said Circular directs exclusiveness of funding source by expressly providing that no one shall receive the cost of living allowance from more than one source.

Based on the aforecited provisions, authorizations granted to government employees to receive cost of living allowance, including allowances granted under RA 5447 are therefore terminated as of December 31, 1978. Hence, unless expressly provided for under subsequent law, only the cost of living allowance provided under LOImp No. 116 as implemented by MBC No. 329 s. 1980 at Ploo each per month, is allowed.

In view of the foregoing, the cost of living allowance for teachers paid by the Local School Boards of Pasay City and Caloocan City is deemed terminated as of December 31, 1978.
