- 1. The Institute of Environmental Planning of the University of the Philippines, Diliman, Quezon City announces its Master in Urban and Regional Planning (MURP) Program.
- The program, focusing on urban and regional planning as a strategy in national development, is designed particularly to produce capable professional urban and regional planners whose training and outlook will fit the needs of a developing country like the Philippines. It will take two years of full-time and about three to four years of part-time study to finish it.

The applicant must pass the Institute's entrance written examination and oral interview, which is scheduled this year on April 30 and May 3-7, respectively. Application forms are available at the Administrative Office of the Institute, or may be requested by writing to the Director of Graduate Studies, Institute of Environmental Planning, U. P. Diliman, Quezon City.
