1. The National Scholarship Center, this Ministry, will award scholarships in Medicine and graduate fellowships in the fields of Mathematics and Physics, allocating one slot for every region for school year 1982-83.

2. The qualifications of the candidates for said scholarships and other pertinent information such as documents to be submitted are stated in the inclosure.

3. Applicants should be duly recommended by the regional director who has jurisdiction over the province/city they represented in their baccalaureate course. All documents should reach the National Scholarship Center not later than April 30, 1982.

GUIDELINES IN THE SELECTION OF CANDIDATES FOR SCHOLARSHIP GRANTS
IN MEDICINE AND GRADUATE FELLOWSHIPS IN MATHEMATICS AND PHYSICS

For Medicine

The candidate must:

1. have completed his baccalaureate degree with major field of concentration in life science;
2. have obtained a general weighted average of "2.0," "85%," "B" or better in his undergraduate course;
3. present a certificate of admission to the College of Medicine of an institution of excellent standing, preferably that of the University of the Philippines, West Visayas State College or any other state college/university offering the medical course;
4. rank first among all candidates in the region where he is a bona fide resident; and
5. be willing to sign a scholarship agreement with the National Scholarship Center.

Applicants for this scholarship are required to submit the following documents:

1. Transcript of Records;
2. Certificate of Admission to the College of Medicine; and
3. Certification of need for medical graduates by the Provincial Governor/City Mayor.

For Graduate Fellowships in Mathematics/Physics

The candidate must:

1. have been a state scholar or an awardee of a scholarship or study grant administered by the Center, major in Mathematics or Physics;
2. have obtained a weighted average of "2.0," "85%," "B" or better in his undergraduate courses;
3. have at least two years teaching experience in Mathematics/Physics;
4. have an efficiency rating of "Very Satisfactory" or better for the last two years;

5. rank first among all candidates in the region which he represents;
6. be a resident of the region based on the allocation of the provincial/city he represents; and
7. be willing to sign a scholarship agreement with the National Scholarship Center.

Documents required of applicants for these graduate fellowships are the following:

1. Transcript of Records;
2. Certification of teaching experience in said subject areas; and
3. Efficiency ratings for the last two years.
