CONFERENCE HELD IN KALIBO, AKLAN

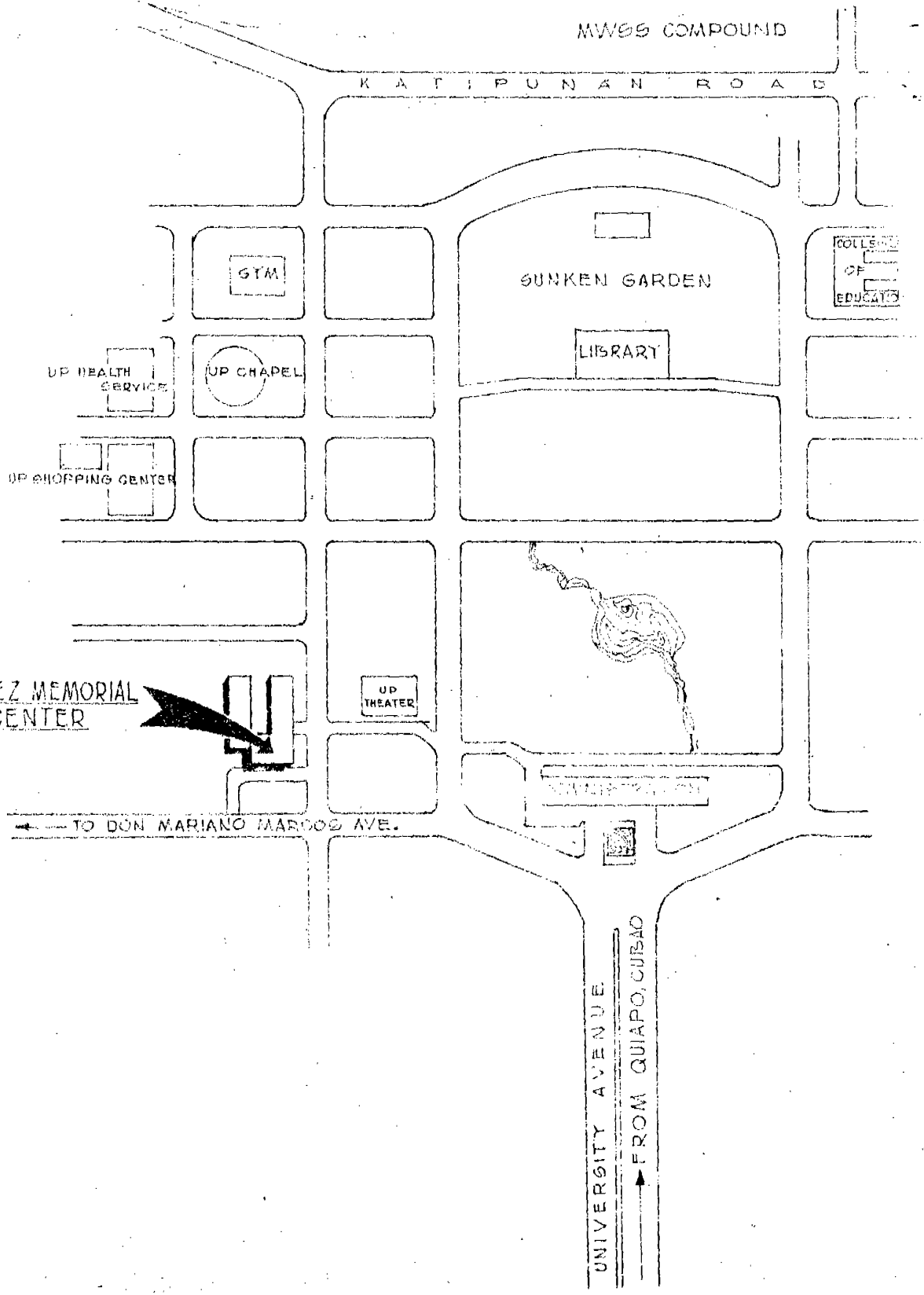
