NATIONAL SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON EFFECTIVE MANAGEMENT
OF SCHOLARSHIP AND STUDY GRANT PROGRAMS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Chiefs of Services and Heads of Units
Schools Superintendents

1. The National Scholarship Center, this Ministry, in cooperation with other offices, will hold a three-day live-in national seminar-workshop on April 21-23, 1982 at the Hiyas ng Bulacan Convention Center, Malolos, Bulacan with the theme: "Effective Management of Scholarship and Study Grant Programs in the Context of National Development Goals."

2. This seminar-workshop is designed to enhance the administrative and managerial effectiveness of participants who, at the end of the workshop, are expected to:

- a. acquire knowledge and understanding of the role, functions and programs of the National Scholarship Center in the national and regional, as well as provincial perspectives.
- b. develop an understanding of the existing rules, regulations, policies, and procedures in the administration of the scholarship and study grant programs
- c. evolve specific educational management techniques which may operate within the specific societal milieu and their implications to democratizing access to education through scholarships and study grants.

- d. formulate workable strategies in career guidance and job placement of graduated beneficiaries.
- e. offer viable and practical solutions to the problems of the cultural communities, rebel-returnees, and rejoiners in the regions concerned, as they relate to the philosophy, goals, and objectives of the scholarship and/or study grant programs.
- f. offer facilitative measures toward bringing to the clientele the maximum benefits of the programs.

3. The names of officials of selected regions/divisions who are authorized to attend this seminar-workshop, the different committees, and daily program of activities are listed in the inclosures to this Memorandum.

4. Expenses to be incurred by the participants incident to their seminar-workshop attendance shall be borne by the National Scholarship Center. To facilitate payment of their travel fare, per diems and other legitimate expenses, all participants are requested to submit without delay the Disbursement Voucher, together with the Itinerary of Travel and Appendix B of previous travel, if any, the expenses for which were underwritten by the Center.

5. It is desired that the contents of this Memorandum be brought to the attention of those concerned.
