SUMMER TRAINING PROGRAM FOR SCHOOL HEALTH  
GUARDIAN FOR PAGLINGAP SCHOOLS

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents

1. The Ministry of Education and Culture, through the School Health and Nutrition Center (SHNC) and the Baguio Vacation Normal School (BVNS), will offer summer training to teachers and administrators of the seven (7) Paglingap schools of the country as part of its Staff Development Program. The program will be conducted at the BVNS, Teachers Camp on April 20-May 15, 1982.
2. Participants in this summer training program will be composed of seven (7) teachers, including the head teacher of the Paglingap schools; the district supervisor where the Paglingap school is located; division Paglingap coordinator; division non-formal education coordinator and one (1) curriculum writer. The list of the Paglingap schools, consultants and resource persons are inclosed with this Memorandum.
3. The objective of the training program is to upgrade the competencies of teachers and administrators in Paglingap schools through:
  - a. development of innovative approaches in integrating core concepts in the curriculum;
  - b. preparation, revision and enrichment of materials for use in Paglingap schools; and
  - c. supervision/management of Paglingap schools.
4. Advanced courses to be taken are:
  - a. Preparation of Self-Learning Materials
  - b. Educational Media
  - c. School Health Guardian
5. A daily stipend of ₱30, tuition fees and transportation expenses of each participant will be given by the SHNC, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. It is understood, however,

that each participant will pay BVNS his/her board and lodging. Air transportation may be used by the participants provided they pay the difference between the ordinary boat/land and plane fares.

6. Transportation expenses and per diems of consultants and resource persons will be charged against BVNS.

7. Participants are expected to bring their lesson plans, prototype curriculum for Project Paglingap, instructional materials used and an honest evaluation of the project, including a detailed accomplishment report, problems in the school, baseline data of the Paglingap school enrollees such as health and nutritional status, socioeconomic status, spot map of the school and community served, school and community projects undertaken, etc.

8. It is desired that the contents of this Memorandum be brought to the attention of all concerned.
