2ND RANAGAWA BIEMWIAL WORLD CHILDREN'S ART EXHIBITION

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities

- 1. The 2nd Kanagawa Biennial World Children's Art Exhibition will be held in March 1983 at the Gallery of the Kanagawa Kemmin Hall in Yokohama. The first Kanagawa Biennial was held in March 1981 with a participation of 22,479 works (13,747 children of Kanagawa, Japan and 8,762 from 65 other countries).
- 2. The Kanagawa Biennial is an international festival of children's art organized and established by Kanagawa Prefecture, Japan in 1980. It is aimed at promoting international understanding and cultural exchange among the children of the world through paintings.
- Considering the absthetic value of art in our everyday living and its significant contribution in fostering the dreams and creativity of children who are the standard bearers of tomorrow's world, it is urged that qualified elementary school children participate in this Exhibition. Along this line, all elementary schools, especially member schools of the National Federation of UNESCO Clubs and Associated Schools project on education for international cooperation and peace, are enjoined to support this world-wide festival.
- 4. The detailed information on this Art Exhibition are as follows:
 - a. Qualification Applicants must be between the ages of four and fifteen as of September 30, 1982.
 - b. Entries
 - (1) Subject Free
 - (2) Materials Open

Applicants may use water colors, oil solors, erayon, pastel, prints, collage or any other materials or methods. Plastic works will not be accepted because of their fragility.

Size - Not exceeding 55 x 55 cm.

Works shall be made by the children themselves. Works already submitted to another exhibition or contest will not be accepted, and neither will be the works produced joints by children. Only one work will be accepted per child.

c. Application

In sealing in their work children are required to write clearly (block letters) in the inclosed form their name, as , sex, address, subject of the paintings, the date of production, and also the school year, the name and place of their school, kindergarten, etc. if attending school. Paste the form firmly on the reverse side of their painting and submit their entry preferably by mail to arrive not later than September 30, 1982 to the following address:
