- 4. Participants will be initially screened by a committee from the CSC. Screening will be based on the participants' educational qualifications, skills and experience in academic research. Those who pass the screening will be efficially allowed to join the contest.
- 5. In addition to a plaque, the fullowing prizes will be awarded to winning entries: 1st prize, \$750,000; 2nd prize, \$730,000; and 3rd prize, \$720,000.
