CONFERENCE ON TECHNICIAN TEACHER  
EDUCATION AND TRAINING

To: Bureau Directors

1. A Conference of Technician Teacher Education and Training in the Philippines will be jointly conducted by the Philippine Government and the Colombo Plan Staff College for Technician Education, Singapore, from June 21 to July 2, 1982 at the Technological University of the Philippines - Visayas Technician Institute, Talisay, Negros Occidental.
2. The purpose of the conference is to bring together a pool of resource experts, management and senior staff of technical institutions for an open discussion touching on mechanism for pre-service and in-service staff development for technician teachers and provide inputs for structuring technician teacher education systems. Such inputs will take the form of policies, guidelines, memorandums and orders.
3. Expected outcomes of the conference will be policies, guidelines and strategies for implementing staff development programs and an action plan for staff training and re-training for each institution.
4. Participants in the conference will be senior school officials who are directly supervising technical teacher education and training. Two participants from each of the participating schools listed in the inclosure may attend the conference.
5. Considering the significance of the conference in upgrading the competency of technician teachers in the country, it is enjoined that school officials involved be encouraged to participate in the conference.

6. Expenses incident to attendance in the conference may be charged against local or institutional funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules.

7. It is desired that the contents of this Memorandum be widely disseminated to all school officials concerned.
