- 1. Conformably to MEC Order No. 46, s. 1979, and MEC Memorandums Nos. 181, s. 1980, and 180, s. 1981, the Planning Service is conducting a Correspondence Course in Educational Planning and Management (CCEPM).
- 2. The general objective of this course is to provide basic understanding of the fundamental elements and some intricacies of educational planning and develop management skills in the clientele of the program among whom are MEC officials operating at the regional, division, district and institutional levels of education as well as from other offices under the Ministry of Education and Culture.
