1982 EDUCATIONAL EXECUTIVES CONGRESS

To: Deputy Ministers

1. The 1982 Educational Executives Congress sponsored by the Ministry of Education and Culture will be held on May 29-June 3, at the Teachers Camp, Baguio City.
2. With the theme "Agenda for the 80s," the Congress will focus on trends and prospects in various areas - economy, labor requirements, energy, environment, population, national security, political development - and their implications in education.
3. The following are authorized to attend the Congress: deputy ministers, assistant secretaries, bureau directors, assistant bureau directors, head executive assistant, service chiefs, executive directors, assistant executive directors, regional directors, assistant regional directors, schools superintendents, assistant schools superintendents, vocational schools superintendents, and their assistants, division chiefs in the general and regional offices, presidents of state colleges and universities, and 200 heads of private schools, colleges and universities representing the Catholic Educational Association of the Philippines (CEAP), Association of Christian Schools and Colleges (ACSC), Philippine Association of Colleges and Universities (PACU), and other associations of private institutions.
4. A registration fee of ₱700 shall be charged each participant to cover conference expenses including those for handouts and board and lodging at Teachers Camp. Minus board and lodging at Teachers Camp, the registration fee shall be ₱350 only.
5. Congress fees and expenses for transportation, board and lodging, and other items that may be incurred in connection with attendance thereto, whether as delegate or as member of the working committees, shall be charged against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules. Members of the Secretariat and Publicity Committee, however, shall charge their travel expenses against OMEC funds. Private schools and organizations may have their own arrangements regarding the expenses of their own delegates.

- 6. In order to economize, associations like the PASS, VCAP and PASUC are hereby authorized to hold their annual conventions one day before or after the Congress. In this connection, the PASS is authorized to collect a registration fee of P100 from each member chargeable against local funds, subject to availability and the usual accounting and auditing regulations. PASS members who are not included in Paragraph 4 are authorized to attend only during the PASS convention.
- 7. Registration of delegates shall be on Friday, May 28, at 1:00 P.M., at the Teachers Camp. Registration before May 28, however, will be entertained at the Personnel Division, MEC, Arroceros, Manila.
- 8. Inclosed are the list of working committees and the tentative program of activities.
- 9. Formal native attire is requested at the opening ceremony.
- 10. Immediate dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum to all concerned, particularly the members of the working committees, is desired.
