1982 SUMMER INSTITUTE FOR THE TEACHING OF CERTAIN  
TERTIARY SUBJECTS IN PILIPINO

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. For teachers in Pilipino in both public and private schools, this Office is pleased to announce that the Philippine Normal College and the National Teachers College, both in Manila, have released their respective programs for 1982 Summer for the teaching of certain tertiary subjects in Pilipino, pursuant to MEC Memorandums No. 40, s. 1979 (1979 Summer Institute for the Teaching of Certain Tertiary Subjects in Pilipino) and No. 102, s. 1980 (Centers for Faculty Training in Pilipino as a Medium of Instruction on the Tertiary Level).
2. This institute will follow the 1982 Summer Session Calendar and every year thereafter as prescribed by the Ministry of Education and Culture.
3. The Philippine Normal College will offer the same program described in MEC Memorandum No. 40, s. 1979.
4. The National Teachers College will offer a six-week intensive reconceptualization on the teaching of General Psychology and Philosophy in Pilipino in addition to those subjects contained in MEC Memorandum No. 40, s. 1979. The units earned in this program will be credited in the regular Master of Arts curriculum. For the doctoral program, Research in Teaching and Analysis of Educational Trends and Problems will be taught in Pilipino. The units earned in these subjects will likewise be credited in the regular Doctor of Education program.
5. All other particulars are the same as contained in MEC Memorandum No. 40, s. 1979.
