FOLK DANCE WORKSHOP

1. The Philippine Folk Dance Society, aware of the continuing goal of the New Republic to inspire pride in our history and cultural heritage, has spearheaded efforts to preserve folk dances in its authentic form through a Folk Dance Workshop on April 25, May 2, 9 and 16, 1982 at P. Gomez Elementary School, P. Guevarra St., Sta. Cruz, Manila, from 8:00 A.M. to 4:30 P.M.
2. The main objective of the workshop is to create greater awareness and appreciation of Philippine folk dances as a cultural heritage.
3. The Ministry of Education and Culture, aware of the importance of this activity, is extending its support to the Philippine Folk Dance Society by allowing interested administrators, supervisors and teachers who are dance enthusiasts to attend this workshop on official time only. Expenses, however, shall be from personal funds. Classroom teachers shall be entitled to service credit.
4. A seminar fee of P75.00 to cover membership fee and handouts will be charged each participant.
