MASTER OF HOME ECONOMICS (M.H.E.)
Objectives

This degree program is designed to (a) update home economics teachers in specialized areas of home economics for pre-school, elementary, secondary, or college teaching and (b) broaden the range of knowledge in different areas of home economics for competent leadership in teaching, supervision and administration in academic and non academic fields.

ADMISSION

Graduates of any recognized university with a major in home economics who had at least two years of active teaching experience.

School administrators and/or supervisors of home economics in elementary and secondary schools with bachelor's degree.

A student who has not previously taken course required in preparation for graduate work is expected to make up his deficiencies. The amount of such additional work shall be determined in each instance by the adviser on the basis of the student's work.

Applicants who are graduates of the University of the Philippines shall be required to submit a certified copy of their academic records from the registrar. For other applicants, the application for admission shall be accompanied by:

1. Two copies of the official transcript of records from each college or university attended.
2. Letters of recommendation from two professors in the undergraduate major field of study certifying, among others the moral character and the ability of the applicant to pursue graduate work conducted in the English language. Such letters are to be sent directly to the Office of the Dean, College of Home Economics.

Applications for admission must be received by the Office of the Dean not later than the first day of registration.

PROGRAM OF STUDY

The degree of Master of Home Economics shall be awarded to a candidate who shall have completed a total of thirty-two units of approved work in the university, twenty-four units in the major field, and the rest is not more than two cognate fields.
