SCHOLARSHIP GRANTS UNDER THE PANGULO
SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

To: Bureau Directors

1. The Kabataang Barangay Foundation, Inc. and the Ferdinand E. Marcos Foundation, Inc. in collaboration with the Ministry of Education and Culture through the National Scholarship Center, constituted the Pangulo Scholarship Program pursuant to a letter of KB Executive Director Moises S. Millena dated October 6, 1981.

2. The PSP is envisioned towards the development of the leadership potential of the Filipino youth imbued with the ideals of the New Republic and committed to the goals of the Democratic Revolution. The program is, likewise, in pursuance of the philosophy of democratizing access to education or equalization of educational opportunity.

3. This scholarship program will commence with school year 1982-1983. It is funded by the Ferdinand E. Marcos Foundation, Inc. and entrusted to the National Scholarship Center.

4. As its initial operation, the Pangulo Scholarship Program will allot the first 150 scholarship slots for SY 1982-1983 to the thirteen regions in the following manner:

5. The 150 Pangulo Scholarship Program awardees for SY 1982-1983 will be filtered out from the 998 examinees who took the National Scholarship Examinations jointly administered by the National Scholarship Center and National Educational Testing Center last January 24, 1982. The qualified applicants will be notified individually by the National Scholarship Center. Their names will, likewise, be published in a newspaper of general circulation.

6. The awardees will pursue courses under any of the following fields of study and prescribed schools:

Physical Education : University of the Philippines
College of Physical Education
and Silliman University

Industrial Education : Technological University of the
Philippines, Cebu Institute of
Technology and Mindanao State
University-Iligan Institute of
Technology

Physics/Mathematics : University of the Philippines
at Diliman and De La Salle
University

Agricultural Engineering: University of the Philippines
at Los Baños
: University of the Philippines
at Diliman

7. The Pangulo Scholarship Program awardees are entitled to a monthly living allowance of P5,000 per school year, exclusive of tuition and other fees, the grant of an annual book allowance of P600 or P300 per school semester and other financial privileges. They shall receive their allowances direct from the Kabataang Barangay Foundation, Incorporated.

8. Other pertinent information on this scholarship program will be provided in the Manual of Information on the Pangulo Scholarship Program which is to be issued later.

9. To ensure smooth operation of this Program, all school officials concerned should coordinate their activities with the National Scholarship Center, this Ministry.

10. Immediate dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum to those concerned is hereby enjoined.
