21ST ANNUAL CONVENTION/LECTURE DEMONSTRATION SESSIONS OF THE

1. The Philippine Association of Language Teaching (PALT) in cooperation with the Ministry of Education and Culture (MEC) will hold its 21st Annual Convention/Lecture Demonstration Sessions at the Benitez Theater, College of Education, University of the Philippines, Diliman, Quezon City on May 10-12, 1982.

2. The theme of this year's convention is 'Making Language Learning Functional.' The main goal of PALT as a professional organization of language educators of our country is to continually explore and review recent developments in research in the field of language and language learning and teaching.

5. Delegates from the public schools may charge their expenses incident to their attendance at this activity against local funds, subject to availability and the usual accounting regulations. Those coming from private schools may have their own arrangements with their respective schools.
