SCHOLARSHIP GRANTS TO FILIPINO STUDENTS
FOR A SEVEN-YEAR STUDY OF ISLAMIC RELIGION

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors

1. The Republic of Indonesia through its Department for Religious Affairs is offering two (2) scholarship grants to Filipino students for a seven-year study of Islamic religion, which includes a one-year study of the Indonesian language for the school year 1982-1983.

2. Candidates for the scholarships may either be high school graduates or college graduates.

3. The grants include Rp. 50,000 monthly allowances for high school graduates and Rp. 75,000 for college graduates. However, transportation expenses to and from Indonesia shall be borne by the participant.

4. Documents required for submission are: (a) copy of certificate or diploma of graduation; (b) medical certificate; (c) Parent's consent; and (d) recommendation of any sponsor.

5. The required papers along with the names, birth certificate and educational attainment of the candidate must be submitted on or before June 30, 1982 to the Embassy of the Republic of Indonesia through the Office of Islamic Affairs, Philippine Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Manila.
