VOCATIONAL EDUCATORS' CONFERENCE

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

1. The Ministry of Education and Culture jointly with the Philippine Association for Vocational Education (PAVE), Inc., Federation of Associations of Vocational Institutions of the Philippines (FAVIP), and the Vocational Colleges Association of the Philippines (VCAP), will hold a Vocational Educators' Conference at the Zamboanga School of Arts and Trades, Zamboanga City, on October 26-29, 1982.

2. The theme of the conference is "Towards Improved Management and Productivity of Technical Vocational Education."

3. The objectives of the conference are:

- a. to enhance active participation of vocational technical schools in the national livelihood program;
- b. to improve the management system of vocational technical schools; and
- c. to present a position on the proposed Bureau of Technical Vocational Education.

4. The participants to this conference are:

- a. heads of vocational trade, agriculture, fishery, craftsmen and comprehensive schools.

- b. representatives of PAVE school chapters and institutional representatives of the FAVIP and VCAP.
 - c. chiefs of secondary and higher education divisions of regional offices and regional and division vocational education supervisors.
5. Travel expenses of participants, including a fee of P600 to cover conference materials and other operating expenses, shall be charged against local school funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
6. The Director of the Bureau of Secondary Education is designated coordinator of this activity and shall create commissions and committees and appoint members thereto to effectively implement the intent and purposes of this conference.
7. In view of the importance and the benefits the Ministry shall gain through this conference in terms of policy formulations and towards effective implementation of vocational/technical education programs, the full cooperation of all concerned is desired.
8. Wide publicity of this Memorandum is requested.
