1982 SEARCH FOR THE THIRTEEN OUTSTANDING .VOCATIONAL SCHOOL TEACHERS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators
and Principals

- 1. The Philippine Association for Vocational Education (PAVE), Inc., in cooperation with the Ministry of Education and Culture, will conduct a nationwide search for thirteen (13) outstanding vocational school teachers, i.e., one from every region for 1982.
- 2. The search is open to the staff of vocational schools and colleges classified as teachers under the provisions of Sec. 2, par. 2 of the Magna Carta for Public School Teachers. Prospective candidates for nominations should be properly screened and ranked according to the criteria attached to the inclosed nomination sheet. Teachers in vocational schools who have been integrated with chartered colleges and universities may also be nominated by their respective school heads or deans through the regional director for proper screening.
- Regional directors are requested to nominate not later than September 30, the most outstanding vocational school teacher from their respective regions. The name of the regional winner should be submitted to PAVE Office, c/o Bureau of Secondary Education, Arroceros St., Manila. The nominees or the winners are requested to report to the Zamboanga School of Arts and Trades, Zamboanga City on October 27, 1982 to receive their awards, with allowable traveling expenses chargeable against their respective school funds.

- 4. The winners will receive plaques of distinction during the vocational educators conference, hence their attendance at the conference is hereby authorized. In addition, if the nominee is a non-PAVE or a non-life PAVE member he will be granted life membership in the PAVE and in the Mutual Aid System. If the nominee is already a life member of the PAVE and the Mutual Aid System, he shall be awarded the money value of such membership in the amount of P550. Awardees may be recommended for a one-step merit increase.
- 5. It is desired that this Memorandum be immediately disseminated for the information and guidance of all concerned.
