## 1982 SIGHT SAVING WEEK

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Chiefs of Services and Heads of Units
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

- 1. The 1982 Sight Saving Week will be celebrated from August 2 to 8, the theme of which is "Treasure Your Eyes".
- 2. In this connection, the following objectives have been formulated for the Week's celebration:
  - a. Foster consciousness of the value of good eyesight.
  - b. Intensify current sight saving programs to solve identified problems of poor sight among school children.
  - c. Encourage established sight saving services of various agencies.
- 3. All efforts should be exerted to maximize the impact of the Week's celebration on children and youth. The following are some suggested activities:
  - a. Eye examination/vision testing of all school children and youth using the Snellen Chart.
  - b. Integrating lessons on the proper care of the eyes in the different subject areas to emphasize the value of good eyesight.
  - c. Inviting eye specialists to render free services to school children, out-of-school youths, those attending adult education classes, and patients from indigent families.

- d. Increasing community awareness through public education on the proper care of the eyes and prevention of eye diseases through the TV, radio, magazines or newspapers.
- e. Staging playlets.
- f. Conducting contests.
- 4. A brief report on the activities undertaken should be included in the Annual Report of Schools Superintendents and Regional Directors.
- 5. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to all schools is desired.
