NATIONAL SEMINAR FOR MANAGERS AND TUTORS
OF THE DISTANCE LEARNING DELIVERY SYSTEM

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents

1. To facilitate the implementation of the Distance Learning Delivery System under the Office of Nonformal Education, a series of national level seminars will be held on the following dates and venues:

- a. July 21-22, 1982 - Aurora A. Quezon Elementary School, Manila for Regions I, II, III, IV, V and NCR
- b. July 27-28, 1982 - Surigao City for Regions IX, X, XI and XII
- c. July 30-31, 1982 - Cebu City for Regions VI, VII and VIII

Inclosed is the program of activities.

2. The objectives of the seminars are to:
- a. familiarize the managers and tutors with the philosophy and rationale of the DLDS;
 - b. orient the participants with the objectives of the program; and
 - c. acquaint them with the guidelines in its implementation.

3. Inclosure No. 2 contains a list of participants representing the 13 pilot divisions, namely: La Union, Isabela, Olongapo City, Pasay City, Oriental Mindoro, Camarines Sur, Iloilo City, Mandawe City, Ormoc City, Basilan City, Ozamiz City, South Cotabato, and Maguindanao. In addition, the following are expected to participate: district supervisors, district coordinators, and seven (7) high school teachers, one for each learning area (communication arts in English, communication arts in Pilipino, social studies, mathematics, science, practical arts (boys) and practical arts (girls), who should be recommended by their respective superintendents based on the criteria stated in MEC Memorandum No. 127, s. 1982. The names of these delegates should be sent to the Office of Nonformal Education on or before July 16, 1982.

4. Expenses incurred relative to this activity, including the registration fee of One Hundred Pesos (P100) for miscellaneous expenses, handouts, and supplies is chargeable against ONFE funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations.

5. Immediate dissemination to all concerned and compliance with the contents of this Memorandum are earnestly requested.
