LINGKOD BAYAN EDUCATIONAL AND FUND CAMPAIGN

1. Inclosed is a copy of Proclamation No. 2217, dated July 3, 1982, of His Excellency, President Ferdinand E. Marcos, authorizing the Lingkod Bayan to conduct an educational and fund campaign from June 1 to December 31, 1982.

2. The Lingkod Bayan, a non-profit organization composed of all cabinet ladies and engaged in various activities for the promotion of the national well-being and prosperity, is at present committed to the construction of the Lungsod ng Kabataan Recreational Park. For this commitment and for other projects similarly geared towards the development of our country and people, the Lingkod Bayan needs the cooperation and involvement and the unqualified moral and financial support of all concerned in order to realize its goals.

3. The Proclamation specifically calls upon "all citizens, residents regardless of nationality or creed, business firms, civic, religious and educational institutions to support actively and generously of their time and means" towards the realization of the objectives of the association.

4. This Office endorses the fund campaign and appeals to all school officials and students to support the campaign. Attention, in this connection, is invited to the 7th paragraph of the aforementioned Proclamation which states that "all donations or contributions to the Lingkod Bayan shall constitute allowable deductions in full from the income of the donors and contributors for income tax purposes."

5. Wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

PROCLAMATION NO. 2217

AUTHORIZING THE LINGKOD BAYAN TO CONDUCT AN EDUCATIONAL AND FUND CAMPAIGN DURING THE PERIOD FROM JUNE 1, 1982 TO DECEMBER 31, 1982

WHEREAS, the development of our country and people needs the total involvement of all concerned to maximize all efforts towards the realization of said goal;

WHEREAS, the LINGKOD BAYAN in all its programs, projects, and activities has all these times been geared towards the promotion of the national well-being and prosperity..

WHEREAS, the operations of the LINGKOD BAYAN of its very laudable aims and purposes are hamstrung by the lack of nationwide response and financial support by the entire nation.

WHEREAS, the unqualified moral and financial support by all concerned will go a long way towards making the efforts of the LINGKOD BAYAN in coordination with government as positive instruments towards national development.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, FERDINAND B. MARCOS, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law do hereby authorize the LINGKOD BAYAN to conduct a national educational and fund campaign during the period from June 1, 1982 to December 31, 1982.

I call upon all citizens, residents regardless of nationality or creed, business firms, civic, religious and educational institutions to support actively and generously of their time and means towards the realization of the above objective .

It is hereby reiterated that all donations or contributions to the LINGKOD BAYAN shall constitute allowable deductions in full from the income of the donors and contributors for income tax purposes.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I hereunto set my hand and cause the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be affixed.
