NATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP AND STUDY GRANT EXAMINATIONS
SCHOOL YEAR 1983-1984

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Chiefs of Services and Heads of Units
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities

1. The national examinations for scholarship under the State Scholarship, National Integration Study Grant, Selected Ethnic Groups Educational Assistance, Pangulo Scholarship, Teijin Limited Scholarship Programs for school year 1983-1984 will be jointly administered by the National Scholarship Center and the National Educational Testing Center, this Ministry, on January 29, 1983. The test administration for the Design Center Philippines Scholarship and PMO No. 697 Work-Study Grant Programs will be announced later.

The timetable for screening of applicants and other related activities for these examinations are stated hereunder:

a. Screening:

- 1) Publicity period . . . July 26 to
September 30, 1982
- 2) Screening and selection
of qualified applicants
by High School Screening
Committee July 26 to
September 30, 1982
- 3) Deadline of submission
by the High School Screen-
ing Committee of the list
of qualified applicants,
together with the
accomplished application
forms and supporting
documents October 8, 1982

- 4) Deadline of submission by the Division Screening Committee of the consolidated list of qualified applicants (using the forms hereto attached) to the National Scholarship Center, copy furnished the Regional Office. (Supporting documents shall be turned over to the examiner during the examination day.) October 29, 1982

- 5) Deadline of submission to NSC of lists of screened applicants and corresponding remittances, using the enclosed format. The said lists shall be received at the NSC November 29, 1982

b. Test administration:

- Collegiate January 29, 1983
8:00 a.m.-12:00 noon

- Secondary January 29, 1983
2:00-4:00 p.m.

2. The guidelines on the selection of qualified applicants embodied in Inclosure No. 1 to this Memorandum must be strictly adhered to by those concerned.

3. An applicant may apply for a scholarship under more than one program, provided he meets the requirements by indicating in the application form and in the answer sheet; however, the National Scholarship Center reserves the right to select the program most suitable for him.

4. An examination fee of five pesos (P5.00) shall be charged every qualified applicant with the exception of PSP applicants whose examination fees shall be borne by the Kabataang Barangay. Each qualified applicant will be issued a copy of the application form. (Please see sample copy, Inclosure No. 2).

5. The examination fees paid by applicants shall be remitted by the division office to the National Scholarship Center in cash or in postal money order on or before December 1, 1982, together with the list of qualified applicants.

6. The examinations for the aforementioned scholarship and study grant programs shall be conducted nationwide in the same test centers that were used in the last scholarship/study grant examinations.

7. The tests will be administered by designated examiners coming from the Central Office. The examiners to be fielded will brief local examiners and coordinators at least a day before the examination.

8. Applicants must be advised to bring with them a No. 1 lead pencil and their test permits during the examination day.

9. The screening committees are enjoined to observe closely the guidelines formulated for the purpose, especially the income requirement of the applicant's parents, tribe membership for members of cultural communities in order to forestall disqualification of any applicant or any complaint arising as a result thereof. Certification of tribe membership issued by the Regional Director, PANAMIN or its Head Office will be considered valid for the purpose.

10. Immediate dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum to all concerned is desired.

GUIDELINES ON THE SELECTION OF
QUALIFIED APPLICANTS

A. As to Qualifications

1. For the State Scholarship Program

- (a) He must be among the first ten of the graduating class in which he is enrolled as regular fourth year student at the time the scholarship test is given, as certified to by the high school principal;
- (b) He shall be considered "poor" which means that the gross income of his parents or if already dead, the court-appointed guardian is not in excess of ₱12,000.00 per annum, as evidenced by a certified true copy of the 1981 BIR Income Tax Return;
- (c) He must be in good health, of excellent moral character and unquestionable integrity, as certified to by the principal of the high school; and
- (d) He must be a natural-born citizen of the Philippines and shall not be more than 21 years of age at the time of his selection.

2. For the National Integration Study Grant and the Selected Ethnic Groups Educational Assistance Programs

- (a) He must be a bonafide member of any of the national cultural communities, as certified to by the PANAMIN Head Office; or PANAMIN Regional Director;
- (b) His parents' or if already dead, the court-appointed guardians' annual gross income is not in excess of ₱12,000.00 as determined by a certified true copy of the 1981 BIR Income Tax Return;
- (c) He must be graduating from high school during the school year 1982-1983 and must belong to the upper 15 percent of the graduating class excluding students from the non-cultural communities, as certified to by the high school principal or the School Registrar and shall not have earned any unit in college; in the case of those who have

already graduated but have not enrolled in college, a similar certification is likewise required and an affidavit should be executed by the student that it is his first time to take the examination. He must take the NISCT only once;

- (d) He must be physically fit and of good moral character per certification of the high school principal; and
- (e) He must not be over 25 years old at the time of his selection as a grantee.

3. For the Selected Ethnic Groups Educational Assistance Program (elementary graduates)

- (a) He must belong to any of the following "hill" tribes as certified to by the PANAMIN Head Office or PANAMIN Regional Director:

Bugkalot, Alangan, Buid Batangan/
Buid Bangon, Sulod, Palawan, Ata-
Matigsalog, Talaingod, Tiboli,
Manobo Blit

- (b) He must meet the qualification (b) of 2 above, and
- (c) He must belong to the top 5 per cent of the graduating elementary class, non-cultural community students excluded.

4. For the Teijin Scholarship Program

- (a) He must be a Filipino Citizen;
- (b) He must be not more than 21 years of age at the time of his selection as a scholar;
- (c) He must be graduating from high school or a high school graduate whose average rating is 90 per cent or better provided, he has not earned any unit or credit in any post-secondary course;
- (d) He must be of good health, excellent moral character, and unquestionable integrity;
- (e) He must be single;
- (f) He must pass the interview after the test; and

C. As to Documents Required:

1. For SSP, NISGP, and SEGEAP Applicants

- (a) Certified true copy of the 1981 BIR Income Tax Return of applicant's parents or if already dead, the court-appointed guardian (to be attached to the application form which should be duly accomplished and signed by all concerned and submitted to the National Scholarship Center through the examiner during the administration of the test);

- (b) Certification of Tribe Membership in Cultural community by PANAMIN Head Office or PANAMIN Regional Director in case of non-Muslim and by Governor, Mayor, School Principal, Barangay Captain or other responsible officials in cultural communities who are in the best position to certify tribe-membership, in case of Muslim ethnic groups, (applicable only to NISGP and SEGEAP applicants);
- (c) Scholastic records in high school with photograph attached;
- (d) Certificate of good moral character issued by Barangay Captain or School Principal;
- (e) Certification by the Principal that applicant belongs to the top ten of the high school graduating class (only for SSP applicants);
- (f) Certification by the High School Principal that the applicant belongs to the upper 15 per cent of the graduating class excluding non-cultural community members; (for NISGP and SEGEAP (collegiate) applicants);
- (g) Certification by the Elementary School Principal that the applicant belongs to the top 5 per cent of the graduating elementary class, non-cultural community students excluded. (Only for SEGEAP secondary applicants.)

2. For applicants to the Pangulo Scholarship Program

- (a) Copy of his identification card or its equivalent as a KB member or a reproduction thereof;
- (b) Certification from the PKKB Regional Youth Development Director that the applicant possesses excellent potentials of a community leader;
- (c) BIR Income Tax Return of his parents or court-appointed guardian of the previous year proving that the gross annual income is not in excess of ₱12,000.00;
- (d) Form 137 or 138 for fourth year high school;
- (e) Certification by the Principal that he belongs to the upper 10 per cent of the graduating class and that he possesses good moral character;
- (f) National College Entrance Examination (NCEE) rating or a certified reproduction thereof.

3. For the Teijin Limited Scholarship Program Applicants

- (a) Health certificate issued by a government physician;
- (b) Permanent record or report card (form 137-A) in the high school with identification picture;
- (c) Certification of good moral character signed by the secondary school principal.

4. Other Matters

1. Awardees under the Pangulo Scholarship Program will pursue courses under any of the following fields of study and prescribed schools;

Physical Education - U.P. College of Physical Education and Silliman University

Industrial Education - Technological University of the Philippines and Mindanao State University - Iligan Institute of Technology

Physics/Mathematics - U.P. at Diliman, De la Salle University, Ateneo de Manila University, Silliman University and University of San Carlos

Agricultural Engineering - U.P. at Los Baños

Music and Arts - U.P. at Diliman
