RESOLVING LOSSES AND/OR INVENTORY SHORTAGES
OF MEC PROJECT TEXTBOOKS IN THE FIELD

To: Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents

- It has come to the attention of this Office that a number of property and supply officers, district, school and/or teacher custodians do not accept monetary payment for lost Project textbooks. Hence, parents, pupils, teachers and students who have lost copies of the textbooks have difficulty in getting clearance at the end of a school year. School property custodians usually require pupils and students to replace textbooks in kind to maintain the quantity of textbooks for the use of the next year's school children. Although this practice is commendable, the procedure is impractical when the books have not been made available in commercial edition. Thus, please be guided by the following:
  - a. As contained in a previous memorandum, MEC Project text-books formerly referred to as "EDPITAF books" are treated in the same manner as any other government textbooks, especially in the handling, disposing and/or dropping them from accountability and records. Therefore, when the school official responsible and/or accountable for Project textbooks is not negligent in the care and custody of same like when they are lost or damaged due to typhoon, flood, fire, earthquakes, robbery and/or caused by transfer or dropping out of pupils/students without returning the books and their whereabouts are unknown, applications for relief and/or condemnation must be filed in the same way that relief or condemnation of other government property is requested.
  - b. When Project textbooks are lost while in the custody of a user and replacement in kind is not possible, monetary payment shall be made and accepted by the school property custodians. Such payment shall be remitted in the same manner as payment for other government textbooks is made.
  - c. The MEC Textbook Project (Textbook Board Secretariat) under its Commercial Edition Program, has granted reprint-

ing rights to some private publishers, printers and bookstores for the following titles of Project textbooks and teachers' materials:
