FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO NEEDY STUDENTS  
IN BARANGAY HIGH SCHOOLS

To: Regional Directors  
Bureau Directors  
Schools Superintendents

1. Dr. Pedro T. Orata, the founder of the Barrio High School Movement, through the Piglet Project Fund of the Barangay High School, Pre-School and Community College Office, Urdaneta, Pangasinan, is offering assistance to needy students in barangay high schools.

2. The Fund can afford to give each barangay high school ₱3,000 or more, which needy students can use to buy piglets to raise. It is not required that the money be paid back. However, such financial assistance should be acknowledged by the recipients.

3. The money from the Fund may be used to raise other animals aside from pigs, such as chickens, cows or horses. It may also be used to raise mushrooms or in buying and selling fish.

4. It is requested that principals of barangay high schools be informed accordingly, so that those who may be interested can contact Dr. Orata immediately.
