19TH ANNUAL CONVENTION OF THE PSYCHOLOGICAL ASSOCIATION OF THE PHILIPPINES

- 1. The Psychological Association of the Philippines (PAP) will hold its mineteenth annual convention on August 16-18, 1982 at the Philamlife Auditorium, United Nations Avenue, Manila.
- 2. The theme of the convention is "Values and Value Systems and Their Meaning and Implications for Business and Government, Mass Media, Education, Mental Health and Psychology".
- 3. Special features of the convention are: the "Tribute to the Founders"; an information service on job opportunities for psychologists and presentation of "prize-winning" papers and exhibits.
- 4. The objectives of the convention are:
 - a. to contribute to the advancement of learning and teaching in psychology;
 - b. to promote psychology as a scientifically-oriented and ethically-conscious profession;
 - c. to promote human welfare.
- 5. A convention fee of \$\frac{1}{2}00\$ for PAP members, faculty delegates and guidance counselors and \$\frac{1}{2}300\$ for non-PAP members will be charged, subject to the submission by the

sponsoring organization of a post audit report of the collections and disbursements, pursuant to paragraph 3 of MEC Order No. 17, s. 1982. The report shall be submitted to the Regional Director concerned. The convention fee will cover convention materials, snacks, certificate of attendance and the general membership luncheon on August 17 (for PAP members). Expenses of school representatives shall be borne by the institutions concerned.

- 6. Chiefs of higher education divisions of MEC regional offices, psychology instructors, senior educational researchers and guidance counselors are enjoined to attend the convention. Expenses incident to their travel expenses shall be charged against the funds of their respective agencies, subject to the usual auditing rules and regulations.
- 7. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to those concerned is requested.
