 - b. Classroom Techniques and Procedures in English in a Bilingual Context - Feb. 14-March 11, 1983
- 3. Each region is requested to screen and submit the names and pertinent papers of two (2) principal nominees and one alternate for each training course on or before November 15, 1982.
- In the selection of teacher-trainees in Special Education, priority should be given to teachers handling classes for exceptional children like the mentally gifted, mentally retarded, children with behavior problems, visually impaired, hearing impaired, orthopedically handicapped and children with special health problems.
- 5. Grantees will enjoy the usual privileges given to scholars under the MEC Integrated Scholarship Program except book allowance.
