1982 DRUG ABUSE PREVENTION AND CONTROL WEEK

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors

1. Pursuant to Proclamation No. 1192 of the President of the Philippines dated October 19, 1973, Drug Abuse Prevention and Control Week, will be observed from November 14 to 20, 1982.
2. The theme for this year's observance is "The Family Against Drug Abuse". It is focused on the vital role of the family in the prevention and control of drug abuse.
3. All schools, colleges and universities are enjoined to undertake fitting activities that will arouse the youths' and peoples' awareness about the problem of drug abuse and what they can do to combat the problem. Efforts should be exerted to enlist the interest of government and non-government agencies, including socio-civic and religious organizations.
4. As part of the observance of this Week, the National winners of the Search for the Outstanding School-Community Drug Abuse Prevention and Control Project will receive their prize at ceremonies to be held in Manila on November 19, 1982.
5. Inclosed are suggested activities for Drug Abuse Prevention and Control Week. Additional detail about the conduct of the Search for Outstanding School-Community Drug Abuse Prevention and Control Program is also inclosed.

6. An account of the various activities carried out by the schools, colleges and universities during the Week should be included in the periodic report of the Regional Directors to this Office.

1. Logo Contest for the "Comprehensive School-Based Drug Abuse Prevention Program (COSDAPP) (refer to MEC Order No. 34, s. 1982). The names of the first three winners from each region should be submitted together with the consolidated report on the week's observance to the Office of the Minister, Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports, Arroyo St., Manila (Attention: Program Officer, COSDAPP). The winner will be selected from among the submitted

entries. A prize of ₱300.00 will be awarded to the maker of the winning logo. The contest is open to all pupils/students in the three levels of education. Entries should bear the printed name and signature of the winner, teacher's name, school, division, region, grade/year as well as a description of the logo.

ADDENDUM AND CORRIGENDUM TO THE GUIDELINES FOR THE SEARCH FOR THE OUTSTANDING SCHOOL-COMMUNITY DRUG ABUSE PREVENTION AND CONTROL PROJECT

With reference to the Search for the Outstanding School-Community Drug Abuse Prevention and Control Project, hereunder are additional information regarding its implementation:

1. Functionality of action program will consider government thrusts and current programs. **Punctuality** in submitting reports as well as its content will also be considered.
2. Activities undertaken in the schools and communities will be taken as evidence of extent of implementation.

Only group projects assisted, organized or sponsored by the Anti-Drug Abuse Committee will be considered. These should be duly certified by the mayor or barangay captain. These may include in-school and out-of-school youths.

Programs of activities, reports of activities undertaken, minutes of meetings, list of officers, members or participants and other documents will be taken as proof that the activities were undertaken. These will be substantiated by interviews of randomly selected officers and members of the group and community people.

3. With regards to involvement of persons and agencies, members of the division/district/school-community anti-drug committee shall be excluded. Officials will be considered separately from agencies. Participation may be direct or indirect in the form of giving support and/or material contribution.
4. As indicators of program impact on the drug abuse problem, the following will be considered:
 - a. Percentage of reduction of drug abuse and drug related cases will be given the following corresponding points

10. Only the first three national winning districts shall be given monetary prizes of ₱3,000, ₱2,000 and ₱1,000 respectively. They shall also receive trophies, viz:

- First Place - Presidential trophy
- Second Place - Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports trophy
- Third Place - Dangerous Drugs Board trophy

A roving presidential trophy will be passed from one first place winner to the next but will be kept by the district that wins first place, thrice.

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
