1982 POLICY CONFERENCE ON SOCIAL WORK EDUCATION

To: Deputy Ministers  
Assistant Secretaries  
Bureau Directors and Regional Directors  
Chiefs of Services and Heads of Units

Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The 1982 Policy Conference on Social Work Education, sponsored by the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports and the Schools of Social Work Association of the Philippines (SSWAP), in collaboration with the Ministry of Social Services and Development and with the financial assistance from the Fund for Assistance to Private Education (FAPE), will be held at the Centro Escolar University, Mendiola St., Manila on October 4-5.
2. With the theme "Social Work Education: A Future Look", the conference will have the following objectives:
  - a. To re-examine, react, and finalize the proposed Rules and Standards for Social Work Education which includes the proposed new curriculum.
  - b. To contribute/suggest to the finalization of the proposed Sectoral Plan of Social Work Education.
3. The following are authorized to attend the conference: deputy ministers, assistant secretaries; bureau directors; regional directors; division chiefs of higher education in the general and regional offices; service chiefs; presidents of state colleges and universities; presidents/heads of private schools, colleges and universities; deans; directors; heads of colleges, schools and departments of the social work and training officers of the Area Centers of the Ministry of Social Services and Development; and representatives of PASW, PAASCU and other associations.
4. A registration fee of P150 shall be charged each participant to cover conference expenses including food and materials.

5. Fees and expenses for transportation, board and lodging and other items that may be incurred in connection with attendance at the conference, whether as delegate or as member of the working committees, shall be charged against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures. Private schools and organizations may have their own arrangements regarding the expenses of their own delegates.

6. Registration of delegates shall be on Monday, October 4 at 8:00 A.M. at the IMCLA of CEU. Registration before October 4, however, shall be entertained at the Bureau of Higher Education, MEC, Arroceros, Manila and at the SSWAP office at the Philippine School of Social Work, FWU, 1743 Taft Avenue, Manila.

7. Inclosed is the tentative program of activities.

8. Immediate dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum to all concerned, particularly the presidents and deans of colleges of Social Work, is desired.
