## SEMINAR-WORKSHOP FOR CERAMICS TEACHERS AND INSTRUCTORS

- A Seminar-Workshop for Ceramics Teachers and Instructors on the construction of downdraft woodfired kiln will be held on October 11-15, at the Cagayan State University, Tuguegarao Campus, Tuguegarao, Cagayan, Region II, under the sponsorship of the Ceramics Education Association of the Philippines.
- 2. The main objective of the seminar-workshop is to enable ceramics teachers and instructors to construct their own downdraft kilns in their respective schools. Other objectives are:
  - a. to understand and appropriate the theories and principles of design and construction of downdraft woodfired kiln;
  - b. to familiarize ceramics teachers and instructors with the standard supplies and materials needed in the construction of downdraft woodfired kilns and to identify and utilize local materials which may be used as substitutes but can still meet required specifications;
  - c. to develop various skills in the actual construction of downdraft woodfired kilns; and
  - d. to test and evaluate the efficiency of a downdraft woodfired kiln and to be able to apply remedial measures to solve deficiencies.
- 3. One outcome expected **of** this seminar-workshop is the completion of a downdraft woodfired ceramics kiln in the host school and the construction of similar kilns in other CEDAP member institutions.

- 4. Inclosed with this Memorandum is the program of activities. Each member institution or division may send one ceramics teacher/instructor and one building construction teacher/instructor to this seminar-workshop. Regional offices may send one vocational education supervisor. Each participant is expected to submit a report on his participation in the seminar-workshop.
- Each participant will pay a registration fee of Two Hundred Pesos (P200.00) to cover cost of printed materials, e.g., blueprints, instruction sheets and other handouts. The registration fee, traveling expenses and per diems are all chargeable against the schools of the participants, subject to the availability of funds and the usual accounting and auditing regulations.
- 6. In this connection, attention is invited to paragraph 3 of MEC Order No. 17, s. 1982 requiring the submission by the sponsor of a post audit report of the collections and disbursements which should be strictly complied with.
- 7. The members of the instructional staff listed hereunder and who shall provide the expertise in kiln construction will report at the Cagayan State University one week before the start of the workshop and shall stay for another week after the workshop for the completion of the downdraft woodfired kiln:
